***Youth classes are not eligible for cash payout. Top 3 places in each youth class will receive prize packages.

Safety Guidelines for Shooters and Spectators

- All attendees must complete and sign a Liability Waiver before entering the building. When the form is turned in, attendees will be given an arm band that must be worn while on the premise.
- Spectators are not allowed on the range at any time.
- Competitors are only allowed on the range during their shoot times.
- Children are only allowed on the range if competing and only during their shoot times.
- Adults must supervise their children at all times.
- **NO SKY DRAWING ALLOWED!!** Shooters must be able to draw their bow under control and without undue difficulty. If in the opinion of the Range Official a shooter is struggling or resorting to "Sky Drawing" to draw their bow, the shooter will be disqualified and unable to continue the competition. If the shooter reduces their poundage and can then properly draw back the bow, the Range Official can approve them to re-enter the competition.
- NEVER intentionally shoot arrows into the ground.
- Only point bow at intended target.
- Never nock an arrow until the intended target is clear of other shooters.
- No alcohol allowed on premises (this includes parking area).
- No pets allowed on premises or in building.
